Taste of Suzuki Music Camp - August 9-13, 2010.

Here's your chance to sample our Pre-Twinkle Class and/or our Young Violinists Class (see complete descriptions below) for a week this summer. Classes will meet daily at KCMC for 5 days, Monday, Aug. 9th-Fri., August 13th. There will also be a surprise musical guest each day of the week to introduce the children to a new instrument. Children from both classes are welcome to enjoy this presentation as it will occur between the two classes. **Times and fees are as follows:**

Pre-Twinkle, daily from 9:00 a.m. - 9:45 a.m. (5 classes) \$50 + \$12 materials fee

Musical Guest, daily from approximately 9:45 – 10:15, free for all enrolled students

Young Violinists, daily from 10:15 a.m. – 11 a.m. (5 classes) \$75 + \$15 materials fee

**Pre-Twinkle Class: Tuesdays at 5:30, Sept. 14th – Dec. 14th (14 classes)
\$140 + \$12 materials fee (new students only)**

This is the Suzuki Early Childhood Education Class (ECE). It is a parent/child* music class for 1 to 5 year olds designed as a foundation course for further music study. The 45 minute class uses a fixed repertoire of classic songs, rhymes, and rhythm instruments. A cd is provided for home listening but is not used during class. Children learn listening skills, rhythm and beat sensitivity, pitch recognition, and are introduced to basic musical terms and rhythms that will appear in Suzuki piano or violin class. Suzuki ECE differs from other early childhood music programs in that the repertoire does not change with each session. Repetition gives the children a sense of accomplishment as they become increasingly proficient with the songs and instruments. They look forward to singing their favorites!

**Young Violinists Class: Tuesday evenings (time TBA), Sept. 14th – Dec. 14th (14 classes)
\$210 + \$15 materials fee (new students only)**

This is a parent/child* group violin class for 4-8 year olds. Children learn foundation skills using fun techniques and box violins. Proper technique and posture from the start is the key to progress- it's easier to form good habits than to break bad ones! Making a habit of listening at home and daily practice with the parent as the home teacher are important aspects of the class. Real violins are introduced as each individual child is ready and are provided within the scope of this class. Further study will require the child to rent an instrument.
